<b>Action Statement</b>	In early fall, the FPS Board of Education members will establish a process for review of the Board liaison roles and protocols, conduct the review, and make recommended revisions.
<b>Coherence Plan Connection(s)</b>	All Areas
<b>Key Work of School Boards Connection(s)</b>	Accountability
<b>How Will Progress Be Measured?</b>	The Board will regularly check in on the progress of the revision process. Once in place, the Board will reflect on the effectiveness of the revised roles and protocols.
