Download the **Beanstack Tracker** app 
or visit <http://franklinpubliclibrary.beanstack.org>
to register for the Winter Reading Club!

If using the app, search for
Franklin Public Library. On the **Sign-In** screen, click
"**Don't have an account? Sign Up**" to create your profile.
If you already have a profile, just log into your account with your
existing username and password.

Follow the on-screen instructions. You may register as an
individual or family. **A phone number may only be used once
to create an account.** Each age group has a winter reading
program (children, teens, and adults).

 **Children** (0-5th grade): Log the minutes you
read each day (up to 20 hours).

 **Teens** (6th grade- 12th grade): Log the minutes
you read each day (up to 20 hours).

 **Adults** (18 and older): Record **each book**
that is read (up to 30 books).

Earn tickets by reading and participating in activities
for a chance to win a great prize!

Last day to log minutes or check-in reading records is
Friday, February 26.

Prize winners will be called **Monday, March 1.**
