- Once you have five days of reading at least 20 minutes, bring your reading record to a librarian and have it stamped.
- For the first five days you read at least 20 minutes, you will receive coupons to local businesses and events, and a **free book!**
- For each subsequent five days of reading at least 20 minutes, you will receive an entry slip for a chance to win a prize at the end of the Summer Reading Program.
  - You may only win one prize.
- You must turn in your reading record by **6pm, Friday, July 26** to qualify for prizes.

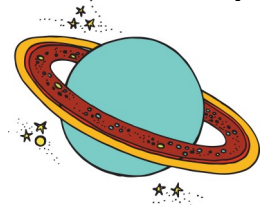
### Edible Book Challenge (All Ages)
